**ITEM: PRESENTATION:** Single Plan for Student Achievement for Bay View, Colton, Crumpton, La Mesa, and Marshall Schools

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### **INTRODUCTION:**

Schools that operate programs funded through the Consolidated Application must develop a plan for improving student achievement utilizing their allotted categorical monies. In addition, each school must demonstrate student academic achievement on the Academic Performance Index (API) and make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP).

If a school does not make improvements on the API and meet the AYP objectives, the Single School Plan for Student Achievement must be revised to specifically address reasons why academic progress was not achieved. The development and revision of the plan is a continuous process that requires schools to establish goals, define specific actions, allocate appropriate resources to fully implement the defined actions, and evaluate progress with specific evidence.

### **BACKGROUND:**

SB 374, introduced by Jack O'Connell and effective 1/1/02, amended Education Code Sections 64000 and 64001 to require each school to consolidate all school plans into a single plan known as the "Single Plan for Student Achievement."

Yearly, the school leadership with the School Site Council must revise and approve the Single School Plan. The Board of Education must review and approve the Single Plan for Achievement for each school. The California State Department of Education has provided schools with an updated template to use beginning this school year.

Schools are updating their plans using the new recommended template and are also including data reports provided by Data Director. The identified goals and many defined actions for each plan will continue through the following school year.

At the beginning of each school year, the school leadership and School Site Council will review student achievement data and other evidence that demonstrate academic progress or areas for improvement.

### **OBJECTIVE(S):**

To review the Single Plan Student Achievement for Bay View, Colton, Crumpton, La Mesa, and Marshall Schools.

**COST/FUNDING SOURCE/FISCAL IMPACT:**

Categorical funds are already allocated to Bay View, Colton, Crumpton, La Mesa, and Marshall Schools for school improvement and are incorporated into the budget for the Single Plan for Student Achievement.



That the Board of Education review the Single Plan for Student Achievement for Bay View, Colton, Crumpton, La Mesa, and Marshall Schools.


