DISCUSSION:



The case is being presented to the Board for consideration for the re-admittance of this student to the Monterey Peninsula Unified School District.


Case 0607/30, the student was found to be in violation of Education Code 48900 (a1) caused, attempted to cause, or threatened to cause physical injury, including mutual combat, and 48900 k) disruption of school activities; defiance of authority and 48900.7 terroristic threats against school officials, school property or both.




A student at King Middle School violated Education Code(s) 48900 (k) while on the King Middle School campus.






